



# Sea Shells

## 2 years—3 years

**Objective:** The child will learn literacy through the letters A, B, and C and will be able to match.

### Materials needed:

Sea Shell Letters Matching (printable)

Glue

### Procedures:

1. Cut out all of the sea shells out individually.
2. Go through all of the ABC cards with your child, saying each letter while showing them. Ask child to "repeat" saying letter after you.
3. Lay all of the small ABC shells on the floor or a small table. Sit with child.
4. Now show child how you can match the same letters by showing them both of the same letters (A and A) at the same time, saying the letter and the letter sound to your child. Do for B and C too. Have child say letters with you.
5. Help with gluing, have child glue the small



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sea shells that match to the larger ones. Such as all of the small shells with the letter 'A' to the large 'A' sea shell picture card.

6. Do this until all small sea shells have been glued and matched to their larger corresponding letter sea shell.

### **Milestones to meet:**

The child begins to recognize and name letters A, B, and C. The child begins to understand how to match "same" letters together. The child learns how to use glue.

### **Evaluation:**

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
