

Objective: The child is introduced to words that are associated with summer and acquires new language through their sense of hearing and sight.

## Materials needed:

Summer Word Cards (printable)

# Procedures:

- 1. Cut out all of the "summer word" cards individually.
- 2. One at a time, hold up to show your child the word, and say the name of it to them. Point to the picture of the word and say it again to your child. Ask your child to try and say the word after you. (I.e. "Can you say beach?")
- 3. Go through all cards until all words are taught in this same manner.
- 4. Optional: Use some of the picture word cards and sing the song on the next page with your child.



# A Summer Word Song:

\*Sung to the tune of Twinkle, Twinkle\*

\*Hold up picture cards when saying the underlined words to help teach your child meaning\*

Ice cream, Ice cream you're so yummy!

In the summer, it is sunny.

We go swimming at the pool,

During summer there's no school!

Picnics, Picnics are so fun!

Summer is for everyone!

#### Milestones to meet:

The child can listen to words and watches pictures when shown; they try to 'repeat' these words through 'mimic talking.' They build their language capacity of unknown words and pictures.
