

Objective: The child can count from 1 to 5 while matching dots on "rays" to the "sun."

Materials needed:

Sun Rays (printable)

Procedures:

- 1. Cut out all of the circle suns and rectangle sun rays.
- 2. Sit with your child on the floor to do this.
- 3. Count while pointing, all of the circle suns with your child from 1-5.
- 4. Showing your child, begin finding how many sun rays belong on each sun. You will have to do one sun at a time.
- 5. Find 1 sun ray (1 dot) to match on the number 1 sun.
- 6. Continue to match sun rays to the suns with your child, building the suns one at a time on the floor.



5.Let child try and find the matches.

- 6. Always count the number after you have matched the rays to the suns, and encourage child to count with you.
- 6. We recommend only focusing on counting from numbers 1—5 at this age.

Milestones to meet:

The child can count with you from 1-5. The child begins to learn how to match same amounts together using dots to help with correspondence.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
