



Cultural Pictures

Ages 1 year—2 years

Objective: The child begins visualizing characteristics of different cultures after shown pictures.

Materials needed:

Cultural Pictures Cards (Printable)
Glue and Poster Board (optional)

Procedures:

1. Cut out pictures individually.
2. Going through each one individually, show them to your child.
3. Use one or two-word verbs and adjectives to describe what is in each picture, and/or what culture it attributes to.
4. Discuss what culture that picture may fall under. Group all pictures in each culture together, and you can glue onto a poster board.



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5. If you have a globe or large wall map at home, you can tape the different cultural pictures to the correct country or location it belongs with. This represents to your child symbols for a place, after explained consistently to them.

Milestones to meet:

The child visualizes differences and similarities in culture characteristics.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
