



Cultural Pictures

Ages 2 years to 3 years

Objective: The child begins to develop understanding of characteristics of different cultures after matching similar pictures together.

Materials needed:

Cultural Pictures Memory Cards (printable)

Procedures:

1. Cut each of the picture cards out individually. Lay them out on the floor or table face up so you and your child can look at them.
2. Sitting with child at the table or on the floor, use one or two-word verbs and adjectives to describe what they see in the pictures.
3. Discuss what culture that picture may fall under. Group all pictures that match together, playing a memory-like game with your child, so your child can see the similarities in them.



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5. Take turns matching similar cultural pictures together with your child.

Milestones to meet:

The child visualizes differences and similarities in cultural characteristics. The child can match pictures together that are the same.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
