



Indian Paint

Ages 3 years—4 years

Objective: The child uses paint and feathers to express themselves.

Materials needed:

Washable finger paint

Indian Paint Sheet (printable)

Feathers (you can find these in any craft section of any large store—such as Wal-Mart or Michael's)

Procedures:

1. [Go here](#) to let your child watch a short song and video about Indians.
2. [Go here](#) to let your child hear the 10 Little Indians song on the computer or phone!
3. Now is the fun part!
4. Let them finger paint the Indian Paint sheet freely. Teach the names of the colors they are using to paint with. Ask child to name colors.



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4. After they are finished finger painting the sheet, have them use feathers to put on top of the paint, making a colorful feather picture collage.
5. Talk to your child about Indians wear feathers and face or body paint to celebrate their culture and heritage in their wardrobe and lifestyle. [Show them a picture of an Indian.](#)

Milestones to meet:
