



My Family

Ages 1 year—2 years

Objective: The child begins to recognize members of their family and learns their names.

Materials needed:

Pictures of Family Members

My Family Tree (printable)

Procedures:

1. Take out a picture of each of the following people in your family, if applicable. Glue them their correct place on the family tree.
 - Mom
 - Dad
 - Brothers
 - Sisters
 - The child themselves
 - Grandma (both maternal and paternal)
 - Grandpa (both maternal and paternal)
 - Cousins
 - Aunts
 - Uncles
 - Pets



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2. Individually point to one picture of a family member at a time to show your child.
3. Say each person by name.
4. Ask your child where is questions. "Where is grandma? Where is Mommy? Where is your brother ___?" and so forth. See if they point to the correct person or pet; for younger 1 year olds, they may not yet, so you will have to ask the question and answer for them, to build this learning skill.

Milestones to meet:

Does the child recognize familiar faces and make name connections with them?

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
