



My Family

Ages 3 years—4 years

Objective: The child can recognize members of their family and names people they know.

Materials needed:

Pictures of Family Members

My Family Tree (printable) & Glue

White paper and crayons

Procedures:

1. Take out a picture of each of the following people in your family, if applicable: Glue to the correct place on family tree. Have child help.
 - Mom
 - Dad
 - Brothers
 - Sisters
 - The child themselves
 - Grandma (both maternal and paternal)
 - Grandpa (both maternal and paternal)
 - Cousins
 - Aunts
 - Uncles
 - Pets



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2. Individually show your child one picture of a family member at a time.
3. Say each person by name, pointing to them on the family tree.
4. Ask your child "where is" questions. "Where is grandma? Where is Mommy? Where is your brother ____?" and so forth. Ask child to point to the correct person or pet.
5. Give them a sheet of white paper and colors. Have them draw their family.

Milestones to meet:

Does the child recognize familiar faces and make name connections with them? Child can name people they know and recognize. Child tries to draw a picture of their family.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
