

Objective: The child begins to develop understanding of storytelling and builds comprehension when answering questions.

Materials needed:

Read and Solve Early Preschool (printable)

Procedures:

- 1. Begin by reading the short passage to your child, showing them the picture of the flag as you do so.
- 2. Afterwards, tell them you are going to ask them questions. Begin doing so.
- 3. Help guide your child to answer the questions by referring back to the story passage or the picture of the flag.
- 4. Continue until all questions have been asked and answered by child
- 5. Think of other discussions you can talk to your child about in regards to the flag.



6. At bedtime, read your child a storybook. Ask questions at the end, to build your child's comprehension skills regarding the book you just read. Make sure the questions are easy for child to understand and refer directly back to the story you just read.

Milestones to meet:

The child listens to a story passage read to them. The child can answer questions after hearing a story. The child builds story comprehension skills and understanding.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
