



Spanish Colors

Ages 1 year—2 years

Objective: The child begins to hear a language in another form, learning colors and hearing their name in both English and Spanish.

Materials needed:

Spanish Color Cards (printable)

Procedures:

1. Cut out Spanish Color Cards individually. Stack together.
2. Go through each of them, like flash cards, with your child, saying the name of the color on the card in both English and Spanish.
3. Go on a color hunt around your house, looking for colors that are of the same colors as shown on the cards. When you see a color, show your child and say that colors name in both English and Spanish. Refer back to the cards as necessary to build the connection in child.



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Milestones to meet:

The child does show willingness to listen to color words spoken in both languages, English and Spanish.
The child learns a recognition for colors.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
