

Objective: The child begins to hear a language in another form, learning colors and hearing their name in both English and Spanish.

## Materials needed:

Spanish Color Cards (printable)

## Procedures:

- 1. Cut out Spanish Color Cards individually. Stack together.
- 2. Go through each of them, like flash cards, with your child, saying the name of the color on the card in both English and Spanish.
- 3. Go on a color hunt around your house, looking for colors that are of the same colors as shown on the cards. When you see a color, show your child and say that colors name in both English and Spanish. Refer back to the cards as necessary to build the connection in child.



## Milestones to meet:

The child does show willingness to listen to color words spoken in both languages, English and Spanish. The child learns a recognition for colors.

## **Evaluation:**

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
