Spanish Colors & Shapes Ages 3 years—4 years

Objective: The child hears a language in another form, saying & recognizing their colors and shapes and hearing their name in both English and

Spanish.

Materials needed:

Spanish Color Cards (printable) Spanish Shape Cards (printable) **Procedures:**

- 1. Cut out Spanish Color Cards individually. Stack together. Do the same with the Shape Cards.
- 2. Go through each of them, like flash cards, with your child, saying the name of the color on the card in both English and Spanish. Repeat the same way for the Shape cards. Always ask child to try and repeat the Spanish word after you.
- 3. Go on a color hunt around your house, looking for colors that are of the same colors as shown on the cards. When you see a color, show your child and say that colors name in both English and Spanish. Refer back to the cards as necessary to build the connection in child.

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- 4. Go on a shape hunt around your house, looking for objects that are of the same shapes as shown on the cards. When you see an object of that shape, show your child and say that shapes name in both English and Spanish. Refer back to the cards as necessary to build the connection in child.
- 5. Following the directions for "Preschool" on the printable sheets—Help your child practice writing the color and shape words on a white sheet of paper, while saying the letters spelling them out.
 Milestones to meet:

The child learns color and shape words spoken in both languages, English and Spanish. The child can recognize colors and shapes. The child can repeat color and shape words in Spanish and tries to write.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
