Days of the Week

1 year—2 years

Objective: The child begins to hear a language in another form, learning the days of the week in both English and Spanish.

Materials needed:

You and your child!

Procedures:

1. Show your child the online Spanish audio calendar. Point to the days of the week on it and say them to your child in English only first.
2. Then, repeat saying the days of the week to your child in Spanish; use mouse and click on days to hear them said in Spanish.

Monday- lunes

Saturday- sabado

Tuesday- martes

Sunday- domingo

Wednesday- miercoles

Thursday- jueves

Friday- viernes



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4. Now sing this fun days of the week song to your child! First time in English (as written), then use the Spanish days of the week words in its place. Point to days of the week on the calendar while singing. It is sung to the tune of "The Adam's Family"
