



# Spanish Numbers

## Ages 1 year—2 years

**Objective:** The child begins to hear a language in another form, learning numbers and hearing their name in both English and Spanish.

### Materials needed:

5 objects of any kind you have in your house:  
Such as 5 different infant toys OR 5 bottles/cups

### Procedures:

1. Sitting on the floor with your child, lay the objects out in front of them.
2. Point to and count the objects 1-5 to your child in English first. Then, re-count them in Spanish. "Uno, dos, tres, cuatro, cinco"
3. If you want, count 1-10 objects to your child in both English and Spanish. "Uno, dos, tres, cuarto, cinco, seis, siete, ocho, nueve, diez"



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4. Now sing this fun number song to your child! It is sung to the tune of "Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star"

uno, dos, number time  
tres, cuatro, number rhyme!  
cinco, seis, OH YEA!  
siete, ocho, MY I SHINE!!  
Nueve, diez, number time  
That is my number rhyme!

### **Milestones to meet:**

The child does show willingness to listen to numbers spoken in both languages, English and Spanish.

### **Evaluation:**

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
