Spanish Words Ages 3 years—4 years

Objective: The child can recognize a language in another form, by recognizing and saying everyday objects after hearing their name in both English and Spanish.

Materials needed:

Spanish Word List and Real-Objects around your home!

Procedures:

- 1. With your child, you are going to walk around your house finding the specific objects on the word list, ask your child to tell you the name of that object in English, then teach them the word in Spanish. Say it, have child repeat you.
- 2. Word list for objects to say in English and Spanish is on the next page.
- 3. Repeat this lesson again & label these objects in the English and Spanish word for print-awareness recognition and refer back to often with your child for best learning to occur!
