

Objective: The child begins to visualize familiar objects and surroundings in their living environment.

## Materials needed:

You and your child at home!

## Procedures:

- 1. Talk with your child about where they live.
- 2. With your child, take them to teach room in your house. Say what room you are in to your child to build association and awareness of what that room is called; such as the kitchen, bedroom, bathroom, or living room.
- 3. Discuss specific features or objects in each of those rooms to teach your child. Point to and show your child those objects, while saying the names of them to build language capacity. Such as pointing to and saying the "TV" and "Phone" in the living room, and "Refridgerator" and "Sink" in the kitchen.



4. Discuss with your child where you live. Tell them these to build early language capacity.
