

Objective: The child builds their knowledge and vocabulary when finding objects that they see.

Materials needed:

Large Macaroni Noodles (uncooked)

Dried beans (uncooked)

Large Soda or Juice plastic jug bottle (Liter works great for this)

Small objects that will fit through lid hole of bottle (need 2 of each of these) Such as: 2 paper clips, 2 colored rubber bands or balloons, 2 pennies or dimes, 2 clothespins, 2 popsicle sticks, & 2 cotton balls

Procedures:

- 1. Before beginning this activity, fill up the bottle halfway with noodles and beans. Add in 1 of each of the items. Close bottle tight, and shake up.
- 2. With your child, show them each object (the 1 of each left out of the bottle). Help them look at the bottle and discover/find the objects with

you.

- 4. When the object is found out of the bottle, set it aside and look for the others inside of the bottle.
- 5. Repeat discovering for objects until all objects have been found or child has no further interest.

Milestones to meet:

The child can look at objects and find them. The child builds their vocabulary by hearing names of objects that they see. They try to repeat words they hear.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
