

Objective: The child makes awareness of letters by matching those in the word THANKS.

Materials needed:

THANKS letters (printable)

Procedures

- 1. Before hand, cut out the letters in the word THANKS. Leave one of the words THANKS built for child to follow and see as a guide word card.
- 2. Sit on the floor or at a small table with your child for this activity. Mix together letters.
- 3. Help as necessary, teaching how to put the cut out letters back in order to build the word THANKS. Start with the letter T, say to child, "can you find T, where does it go?" Point to show and have child put it right underneath the T in the build word card.
- 4. Teach and do for every letter, building the word and using the word card as you and your child's guide. Say each letters name, have child repeat.



Milestones to meet:

The child builds early literacy development through looking at letters, repeating the names, and placing them in order following the word card to build the word together. The child shows a willingness to match same letters together.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
