Turkey Counting Ages 2 to 3 years

Objective: The child builds early math skills by counting numbers 1-10.

Materials needed:

Turkey Counting (printable) Only use 10 turkeys Clear tape

Procedures

- 1. Have your child sit at a small table.
- 2. Cut out the turkey's before hand (use only 10 to teach at this age).
- 3. Hold up one at a time, counting the turkey's to your child, focusing on saying numbers 1-10. Ask child to count them with you.
- 4. Now, using tape, tape them up on a low wall or window in your house.
- 5. Point to each turkey and count them again while your child listens; ask child to count with you!
- Encourage them to use fine-motor skills to grab at the turkey's taped up and pull them down.
 Count them out loud as they pull it off.

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Milestones to meet:

The child listens to numbers 1-10 being counted and shows a willingness to count along. The child uses fine-motor skills and hand-eye coordination by grabbing at pictures of turkey's taped to the wall/window and pulling them off.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
