

Objective: The child builds visual and language development through storytelling.

Materials needed:

Turkey's Storybook (printable)

Procedures

- 1. Sit with your child in your lap.
- 2. Begin by reading the eStorybook to your child. Read slowly, word for word, to really have your child be able to hear the words and sounds you are saying.
- 3. Point to the pictures, say the names of them you see, and describe them to your child. Ask child to say the picture names with you.
- 4. Ask child questions when reading: "What do you see? What is that? What color is it?"
- 5. Complete reading the eStorybook to your child; re-read and visit throughout this month for consistent teaching and learning.



Extension Activity: Have child put the story pictures back in order, sequencing the events. Cut the pictures out at the end of the eStorybook, and using the storybook as a guide, have them put the pictures back in order from what happens first to last.

Milestones to meet:

The child listens and follows along during a story being read to them. The child builds early language development and picture-word association skills. The child shows a willingness to say the names of pictures they recognize in a story.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
