



Cornucopia Craft

Ages 2 to 3 years

Objective: The child will build creativity and fine-motor skills after creating a craft picture.

Materials needed:

Cornucopia Craft (printable)

Crayons or Markers

Glue and Scissors

Procedures

1. Have your child sit at a small table.
2. Before hand, parent cuts the pieces out.
3. Have your child color the pieces.
4. Help your child glue the pieces to a white sheet of paper, building the cornucopia. Teach child where the items go; inside of the cornucopia.
5. Let dry completely.
6. Read a fall or Thanksgiving storybook together. Visit a public library to check one out, or go to a Barnes-N-Noble and read one together today!

Help with gluing as necessary. You glue, they do!



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Optional: For more fun, let your child glue on some real leaves and real pieces of corn kernels, or nuts, to the cornucopia.

Milestones to meet:

The child builds creativity skills through creating a cornucopia craft. The child uses fine-motor skills to color and create.
