



Cognitive:

1st, 2nd, 3rd Sequencing

Ages 2 years to 3 years

Objective: The child will sequence pictures by the events they happen, first, second, and third with the help of their parents.

Materials needed:

1st2nd3rd Sequencing sheet (print from resources page) *Scissors to cut cards out - you use only*

Procedures

1. Sit with your child at a table for this activity.
2. Before activity, cut out the pictures individually.
3. For each "group" of sequencing events, keep them together in separate piles to teach one group of sequencing cards at a time.
4. Start with the first group of pictures. Go over each of the pictures with your child, telling them what is happening. Now lay them all face up on the table. Help your child put them in order from what happens first, second, and third.
5. Now do the second group or sequencing pictures. Tell, show, and teach (learn) the same way as #3.



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6. Continue until all sequencing picture cards have been categorized into 1st, 2nd, 3rd order with your child. Remember to talk and discuss with your child **WHY** the pictures are in that particular order; to build comprehension of what they are doing.

Milestones to meet:

The child begins to understand the concept of sequencing events by looking at pictures and being able to put them in order from 1st, 2nd, and 3rd with the help of their parents.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
