

Objective: The child will match same colors using M&M's candy and sorting them on a graph.

Materials needed:

M&M's candy (2 packages)

Match M&M's graph (print from resources page)

Procedures

- 1. Sit with your child at a table for this activity.
- 2. Put all of the M&M's on a paper plate.
- 3. Put the graph down in front of them.
- 4. Go over all of the colors at the bottom of the graph with your child first.
- 5. Now model and show. Pick up one of the M&M's and put on the graph in the appropriate column.
- 6. Encourage and tell your child to sort the M&M candies based on their colors using the graph.
- 7. Help your child to do until all of the M&M's are on the graph in the correct color columns.

Milestones to meet:

The child can sort similar colors on a graph using M&M's. The child begins to recognize and learn colors by name.
