

Objective: The child builds language and physical development after hearing a song and seeing motions using pumpkin pictures.

Materials needed:

5 Little Pumpkins (print from resources page) Song on the next page

Procedures:

- 1. Have your child sit on the floor with you in a large open area.
- 2. First, make the "pumpkin popsicle puppets" as directed on the printable sheet.
- 3. Begin by singing the song on the next page to your child. Now we are going to add in the motions and movement. Pick up the pumpkins.
- 4. Sing the song to your child and show them the pumpkin people (acting out the song) throughout this week for fun and learning!
- 5. Allow your child to try and use the pumpkin props while singing the song together!



Song and Movement:

5 Little Pumpkins sitting on a fence...

The first one said "Oh my, it's getting late."

The second one said, "There's a chill in the air."

The third one said, "But I don't care."

The fourth one said, "Come on let's run."

The fifth one said, "Let's have some fun!"

And then whoosh went the wind

And out with the night

And all 5 pumpkins rolled out of sight.

Milestones to meet:

The child shows interest in songs. The child shows a willingness to use props during a song to mimic the actions they see in an adult. The child watches as a song is acted out using props.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
