

Objective: The child is able to use physical development and builds new language after hearing a song and mimicking motions using leaves.

Materials needed:

Leaves Song Cutouts (print from resources page) Song on the next page

Procedures:

- 1. Have your child sit on the floor with you in a large open area.
- 2. Begin by singing the song on the next page to your child. Sing it over and over again, 3 times.
- 3. Now we are going to add in the motions and movement. Pick up the leaves.
- 4. Sing the song again, but this time "act it out" by throwing up the leaves in the air while singing.
- 5. Continue picking up leaves and throwing them up in the air, singing the song 3 times in a row.
- 6. Encourage your child to try to grab at the leaves as they fall down, pick them up off the floor, or throw them up with you to imitate your actions through song and movement.



<u>Song and Movement:</u> "Leaves, Leaves falling down Falling to the ground Red, Green, Yellow, and Brown Falling to the ground."

Repeat singing song 3 more times **<u>Next</u>: use leaves for movement by throwing them up in the air as you sing the song**

Milestones to meet:

The child can use fine-motor skills to pick up, grab at, or throw up in the air leaves. The child uses handeye coordination to reach for and grab leaves falling from the air to the ground. The child tries to sing along. The child mimics the actions and movement of an adult.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
