

**Objective:** The child can order pictures according to size using the height of a scarecrow.

## Materials needed:

Scarecrow sizes sheet (print from resources page)
Scissors

## Procedures:

- 1. Sit at a table with your child for this activity.
- 2. Before hand, cut out all of the scarecrows boxes individually. If your child is able to use scissors, have them cut on their own.
- 3. Explain to child that they are going to order the scarecrows in order from smallest to biggest.
- 4. Mix all of the different sized scarecrows on the floor, face up.
- 5. Encourage your child to put them in order (left to right) from smallest to biggest.
- 6. Now mix them up together again.
- 7. Explain and encourage your child to put them in order (left to right) from biggest to smallest.
- 8. Help as necessary.



## Milestones to meet:

The child can order pictures by size. The child understands math words such as "smallest, biggest, littlest, largest."

## **Evaluation:**

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
