



Scarecrow Order By Size

Ages 4 years to 5 years

Objective: The child can order pictures according to size using the height of a scarecrow.

Materials needed:

Scarecrow sizes sheet (print from resources page)

Scissors

Procedures:

1. Sit at a table with your child for this activity.
2. Before hand, cut out all of the scarecrows boxes individually. If your child is able to use scissors, have them cut on their own.
3. Explain to child that they are going to order the scarecrows in order from smallest to biggest.
4. Mix all of the different sized scarecrows on the floor, face up.
5. Encourage your child to put them in order (left to right) from smallest to biggest.
6. Now mix them up together again.
7. Explain and encourage your child to put them in order (left to right) from biggest to smallest.
8. Help as necessary.



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Milestones to meet:

The child can order pictures by size. The child understands math words such as "smallest, biggest, littlest, largest."

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
