

Objective: The child uses their sense of sight to build their perception of fall surroundings after seeing pictures of things associated with the fall season, and the child can repeat fall words after hearing them.

Materials needed:

Seasonal pictures (eSheet)

Procedures:

- Sit with your child at the computer so you can pull up the PDF and look at it with your child at the screen.
- 2. Begin by showing one picture at a time to your child.
- Say the name of the picture while pointing to it.
 Ask your child to repeat the word after you.
 (I.e. "Can you say leaf?")
- 4. Do this same way of teaching until all season cards have been gone through, shown, and said.
- 5. Use as many descriptive words as you can when teaching your child what they may see in each picture as shown on the computer screen.

Milestones to meet:
