Seasonal Pictures

Ages 2 years to 3 years

Objective: The child is able to explain to you what they recognize after seeing pictures of fall surroundings and builds their vocabulary skills while using adjectives.

Materials needed:

Seasonal pictures (eSheet)

Procedures:

1. Sit with your child at the computer. Pull up the PDF file to look at with your child on the screen.
2. Begin by showing one picture at a time to your child.
3. Ask your child to tell you what they see in the picture. (I.e. "What is this?") If child does not know, tell them and then ask to repeat word(s).
4. Do this same way of teaching until all season cards have been gone through, shown, and said.
5. You can teach your child how to describe what they see using adjectives.



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Milestones to meet:

The child recognizes pictures associated with the fall season, and can tell you what they are. The child tries to use adjectives to describe and talk about what they see in pictures resembling the fall season.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
