



Big and Little Turkeys

Ages 1 to 2 years

Objective: The child will learn big and little concepts when looking at different sized pictures of turkeys.

Materials needed:

Big and Little Turkeys (printable)

Scissors

Procedures

1. Have your child sit in their highchair to teach the lesson, so they do not become distracted.
2. Cut out the big and little turkeys before hand.
3. Hold up one at a time, saying whether it is big or little to your child.
4. Use emphasis in your voice when teaching the concept BIG and whisper with little emphasis in your voice when teaching the concept little.
5. Put all of the little turkeys on the tray in front of your child and count them. Ask your child to count them along with you. "Can you count the turkeys with me?"



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6. Hold the turkeys up one at a time again, repeat teaching whether the turkey is big or little.

Milestones to meet:

The child begins learning the concept of big and small after seeing pictorial representations.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
