

Summertime!

Water Painting Windows	With a water spray bottle and large paint brush, have your child spray the windows on the outside of your house and “clean” them using the paint brush and dry with a towel!
Chalk and Water	Have your child use sidewalk chalk outside on the sidewalk or driveway, then using a bucket with water and large paint brush, water paint over the chalk to make it disappear!
Sea Shell Coloring	At any craft store, buy some white sea shells. Lay them on a sheet of paper to protect the table, then let your child use markers to color on them freely!
Writing in Sand	Either in sand (you can find outside, at the park, or buy at the store) or flour, lay some out of the ground for child. Show them how they can make letters in it using their fingers. Say the letters as you write them in the sand together with your child!
Baby Doll Washing	Grab some of your child’s plastic baby dolls, un-dress them. Have them “wash” the babies with a washcloth and bucket of water outside. Show them how to wipe them down first!
Egg Experiment	Outside a hot, sunny day, break an egg open on the sidewalk or driveway. Watch with your child to see what happens to the egg once on the hot pavement? Predict and Conclude what you see happening to the egg as it sizzles on the ground in the hot sun!
