Fun in the Fall

Leaves	Go on a leaf hunt around your neighborhood. When you get home, discover them together! Put them under a white sheet of paper, have child use crayons, & make leaf print rubbings
Apples	Cut them open, count their seeds, use them for "apple prints" painting on white paper!
Birdseed	Give your child a cup and scoop, put some birdseed in a bucket, & have child transfer!
Scarecrows	Using hay, old clothes, & sticks make a large one in your front yard! Use a pumpkin for the head! Let your child draw it a face!
Clothing Sort	Go through your child's closet, have them help! Sort the summer and fall clothes in separate piles! Have them put together matches, such as pants and long sleeve shirt!
Sweet Potatoes	Open up a can, put a spoonful on a paper plate, & "finger paint" on white paper!
Corn Shucks	Build your child's fine-motor skills by letting them help you shuck corn on the cobs!
Acorns	Go on a nature walk, look for & collect acorns. Using tongs & a muffin pan, have your child "pinch" them to build fine-motor skills and 1-to-1 correspondence!
Trees	Have your child make "finger prints" with paint on a tree you draw on white paper! Imitating leaves and apples using red & green paint!
